Today, over 44 million Americans are without health insurance. The uninsured are predominantly low-income, working families and nearly two-thirds (64%) have incomes below 200% of the poverty level (or less than \$30,000 per year for a family of 3 in 2002). For those who are uninsured and underinsured finding affordable, quality health care seems like an unconquerable task. However, Tapestry Healthcare is meeting that challenge by providing affordable, quality health care to the underserved in Collin and surrounding counties. Tapestry is a nonprofit organization that provides health care to the uninsured, the underinsured and the underserved. As of now, Tapestry has provided the following services to over 2,000 families and residents: Primary care; Well child exams; Child and Adult immunizations; Eye screenings for children; Family planning; Blood level screenings; Disease screenings; Language translation and referrals. In September 2005, Tapestry will expand its operations to include Dental services and Patient education programs. Tapestry was founded in 2001, opened its doors in February 2004 as a volunteer clinic, and went full-time in September 2004. On average, Tapestry sees 467 patients a month. With one Certified Physician Assistant and one Certified Medical Assistant as the primary caregivers, seeing that amount of patients means spending many long hours at the clinic. With the rapid growth that Tapestry is experiencing, it is in need of more staff, more medicine, and more medical equipment. Tapestry needs assistance with financing these various needs.
